HIPAA Privacy Notice — Uses and Disclosures of Health Information

THIS NOTICE DESCRIBES HOW MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT YOU MAY BE USED AND DISCLOSED AND HOW YOU CAN GET ACCESS TO THIS INFORMATION. PLEASE REVIEW IT CAREFULLY.

THIS NOTICE GIVES YOU INFORMATION REQUIRED BY LAW about the duties and privacy practices of the Affinity Health Services to protect the privacy of your health information.

Affinity Health Services may obtain your or your representative's consent to use and disclose health information about you for your treatment, payment for care and health care operations. Although federal law does not require consent for these purposes, there are circumstances under state law which may require consent.

For other purposes, Affinity Health Services may request a separate signed authorization to permit use and disclosure of protected health information. Examples of when an authorization will be required for use and disclosure of your health information include: (i) use and disclosure of psychotherapy notes; (ii) marketing; and (iii) research purposes. An authorization to use or disclose information may be revoked at any time to stop future uses and disclosures.

Affinity Health Services may initiate contact to provide information about treatment alternatives or other health related benefits or services without specific authorization.

Clients have the opportunity to agree or to decline the use and disclosure of health to a family member or other individual involved in the resident's care or payment for that care. If you agree, identifying information such as name, address and telephone number may be given over the telephone. With verbal consent, health information may be given to designated persons involved in your care.

Individual Rights

Except in limited circumstances, an individual may review or obtain a copy of protected health information. If you request copies of your protected health information, Affinity Health Services may charge \$.50 per page. You have the right to request additional restrictions on the use and disclosure of health information, to amend that health information and to request that Affinity Health Services communicate by a different means about health information; however, Affinity Health Services is not legally required to agree with such a request. An individual also has the right to receive a list of

instances when Affinity Health Services has disclosed health information for reasons other than treatment, payment, operations, related administrative purposes or pursuant to your authorization.

Complaints

About our Online Advertising Practices
